O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct a spur track at grade across South 4th Street in Patterson, Stanislaus County, at the location described in the application. Said spur track crossing and that of the adjacent drill track shall be identified as Crossing No. BA-107.8-C. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding two per cent. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (G. O. No. 75-B). Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

It is alleged that this track is required for handling of cantaloupes during the season commencing in the first half of July and request is made that this authority be effective immediately. For this reason the effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
