SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

By Decision No. 45209, dated January 3, 1951, the Commission authorized Acme Transportation, Inc. to execute promissory notes and conditional sale contracts on or before April 30, 1951, in the principal amount of not exceeding \$195,399.75, for the purpose of financing the cost of equipment.

By Decision No. 45550, dated April 10, 1951, the time within which applicant could execute the promissory notes and conditional sale contracts authorized by Decision No. 45209 was extended to and including July 31, 1951.

The company now advises that as a result of the national emergency situation and difficulty in acquiring equipment sought to be purchased under the terms proposed in its original application that final delivery of the balance of equipment cannot be made until approximately October 31, 1951. Accordingly, it has requested the Commission to make a supplemental order extending the time within which the notes and contracts may be executed.

The Commission has considered this matter and is of the opinion that the company's request should be granted; therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the time within which Acme Transportation, Inc. may execute the promissory notes and conditional sale contracts authorized by Decision No. 45209, dated January 3, 1951 be, and it hereby is, extended to and including November 30, 1951.

This second supplemental order is effective upon the date hereof.
