FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

In Decision No. 45689 in the above entitled application the Commission authorized Southern Pacific Company to construct two crossings in Placer County in connection with road changes made necessary by the extension of its Roseville Yard.

Said decision provided that applicant bear the entire construction and maintenance expense of these crossings. It appears, however, that the Board of Supervisors of Placer County is agreeable to maintaining certain portions of the new crossings, and by its First Supplemental Order, Southern Pacific Company requests modification of the order.

Therefore good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the second paragraph of Decision No. 45689 is hereby modified to read as follows:

Applicant is also authorized to relocate an existing under-grade crossing of said county road with its tracks (Crossing No. A-105.3-B) as shown on the plan attached to the application, said crossing as relocated to be identified as Crossing No. A-105.1-CB.

Applicant shall bear entire construction expense of both crossings. Maintenance expense shall be in accordance with agreement between applicant and the County of Placer.

In all other respects Decision No. 45689 is in full force and effect.
