OPINION AND ORDER

In this application Pacific Gas and Electric Company asks for authority to carry out the terms and conditions of a contract with Josie Goodwin relating to the purchase of water for distribution and resale by her in and in the vicinity of Sugar Pine, Tuolumne County. A copy of the contract which expires on June 14, 1952, is attached to the application and marked Exhibit No. 1.

The contract provides that Pacific Gas and Electric Company will sell and deliver up to one statutory miner's inch per day during a one-year period and thereafter until said contract dated June 14, 1951, is terminated by thirty (30) days written notice by either party. Water will be delivered to Josie Goodwin at the point where her intake draws water from applicant's main Tuolumne Canal as shown on a map marked Exhibit A, attached to the application. The water will be measured at this point on the canal and sold at the rate of fifty cents (50¢) per miner's inch day.

The contract further provides that the furnishing of water therein is intended merely as an accommodation service.

The Commission having considered the request of applicant and being of the opinion that the application should be granted and that a public hearing is not necessary, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Pacific Gas and Electric Company be and it is authorized to carry out the terms and conditions of the written contract, dated June 14, 1951, with Josie Goodwin, and to render the service described therein, under the terms, charges and conditions stated therein, subject to the following conditions:

1. Applicant shall file with the Commission within thirty (30) days after the effective date of this order, two (2) certified copies of the contract as executed, together with a statement of the date on which it is deemed to have become effective.
2. Applicant shall notify this Commission of the date of termination of said contract within thirty (30) days after said date of termination.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty (20) days after the date hereof.
