OPINION AND ORDER

Leo F. Jarvis, engaged in the business of furnishing domestic water service within a subdivided area known as Jarvis Subdivision, Fresno County, asks for authority to sell and transfer the distribution system to the City of Fresno, a municipal corporation, which joins in the request.

The Jarvis tract is contiguous to the City of Fresno and the city desires to acquire the distribution mains and services, and operate them in connection with the city's municipally owned system. The consideration to be paid for the Jarvis system is \$6,845, said sum to be paid upon close of the escrow as provided by the agreement of purchase. The system is reported to be serving 82 consumers as of December 31, 1950.

The Commission has considered applicant's request and is of the opinion that the proposed transfer will not be adverse to the public interest; that a public hearing herein is not necessary, and that the requests of applicants should be granted, subject to the provisions of this opinion and order, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:

1. That Leo F. Jarvis may, on or after the effective date hereof, and on or before December 31, 1951, sell and transfer the public utility water property described in the application to the City of Fresno, a municipal corporation in accordance with the agreement of purchase, dated May 24, 1951, a copy of which is attached to the application as Exhibit A, and by reference made a part hereof.

2. That on or before the actual date of transfer, Leo F. Jarvis shall refund all consumer deposits, if any, to consumers entitled thereto, and within thirty (30) days thereafter shall notify this Commission, in writing of the completion of such refunding.
3. That within sixty (60) days after the sale and transfer hereabove authorized, Leo F. Jarvis shall notify this Commission, in writing, of the exact date upon which he relinquished control and possession of the water property, being transferred.
4. The action taken herein shall not be construed to be a finding of value of the property herein authorized to be transferred.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
