## ORDER

Avenue at grade across a main line and side tracks of The Atchison,
Topeka & Santa Fe Railway Company near Antioch in that County, at the
location described in the application to be identified as Crossing
No. 2-1149.4. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also
maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. The
Atchison, Topeka & Santa Fe Railway Company shall bear maintenance
cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than
24 feet and grades of approach not greater than 3 per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72.
Protection shall be by 2 Standard No. 8 crossing signals. (G. O. No.
75-B). Plans showing the method of control of said signals shall be
filed for Commission approval prior to installation.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity,

or safety so require.	The effective date of this order shall be
