O R D E R

The Department of Public Works of the State of California is authorized to widen the crossings of State Highway Route 2 at grade with tracks of Southern Pacific Company and The Western Pacific Railroad Company, (Crossing Nos. E-50.4-C and 4G-19.7) respectively, near San Jose, Santa Clara County, as described in the application and in accordance with the plan attached thereto. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72. Protection shall be by existing signs and signals which may be relocated.

Construction expense shall be apportioned by agreement between the parties or, if they fail to agree, by further order of the Commission. Maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails shall be borne by applicant. Maintenance cost between such lines shall be borne by the respective railroad companies.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with.

Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
