ORDER OF DISMISSAL

By petition filed July 10, 1950, William Giacomazzi and Elven Giacomazzi, doing business as Giacomazzi Bros., sought authority to establish reduced rates for the transportation of petroleum and petroleum products.

By petition filed August 9, 1950, Elmer Ahl, agent for carriers parties to Tank Truck Operators Tariff Bureau Tariff No. 3-C, Cal.P.U.C. No. 5, sought authority to publish the same rates as the Commission might authorize in the Giacomazzi petition.

A public hearing was held at San Francisco on August 15, 1950, before Examiner Bryant. The taking of evidence was not concluded and the matters were temporarily removed from the hearing calendar at petitioners' request. Counsel for Giacomazzi Bros. has

now requested that their petition be dismissed. Ahl desires concurrent dismissal of his petition.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above referred to petitions be and they are hereby dismissed.
