ORDER

The Department of Public Works of the State of California is authorized to construct State Highway Route 98 at separated grades under the main line tracks of Southern Pacific Company at two locations, one in ("B" Street Underpass) and the other near (Elvas Underpass) Sacramento, Sacramento County, at the locations shown by maps attached to the application, to be identified as follows:

"B" Street Underpass, as Crossing No. A-91.1-B
 Elvas Underpass, as Crossing No. A-91.9-B

Construction and maintenance expense shall be borne in accordance with agreement entered into between the parties, and copy of said agreement, or agreements, together with plans of said crossings approved by Southern Pacific Company, shall be filed with the Commission prior to commencing construction. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the cost of construction and maintenance by further order.

Applicant is also authorized to temporarily relocate the crossing of 28th Street at grade with tracks of Southern Pacific Company, (Crossing No. A-91.0) as described in the application and in accordance with the plan attached thereto. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.O. No. 72. Protection shall be by existing Standard No. 3 crossing signal and Standard No. 1 crossing sign. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance cost. Upon completion of Crossing No. A-91.1-B

herein authorized said Crossing of 28th Street shall be restored in its present location at expense of applicant.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within two years unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
