ORDER

The Department of Public Works of the State of California is authorized to construct pedestrian crossings of Campbell. Avenue and Marguerita Avenue at separated grades over the tracks of Pacific Electric Railway Company, in Alhambra, Los Angeles County, at the locations as shown by maps (Exhibits A and B) attached to the Second Amendment of Application, to be identified as Crossings No. 6T-6.95-A and No. 6T-7.25-A respectively. Construction and maintenance expense shall be borne in accordance with agreement entered into between the parties, and copy of said agreement, together with plans of said crossings approved by Pacific Electric Railway Company, shall be filed with the Commission prior to commencing construction. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the cost of construction and maintenance by further order. Clearances shall conform to the provisions of G.O. 26-D. Upon completion the existing crossings at grade of Ethol, Campbell and Marguerita Avenues, Crossings No. 6T-6.91, 6T-6.97 and 6T-7.26 shall be abandoned and effectively closed to public use and travel.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within two years, unless time be extended or if conditions are not complied with. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
