
ORDER

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct a spur track at grade across Power Inn Road near Polk, Sacramento County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. D-131.9-C. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.C. No. 72, without superclevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the road now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding three per cent. Protection shall be by two Standard No.8 crossing signals (G. O. No. 75-B). Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require.

Applicant alleges that the industry to be served by this track has recently received governmental authority for construction of its plant. This track is required to receive building materials

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prior to commencement of construction on September 1st. It is therefore requested that the authority, if granted, be made effective immediately. Therefore the effective date of this order shall be the date hereof. A
