O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct a spur track at grade across a portion of Second Street in Berkeley, Alameda County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. A-9.90-C. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.O. No. 72, without super-elevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding one per cent. No additional protection is required. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Applicant is also authorized to deviate from the requirements of Rule 3.17 of General Order No. 26-D provided all other requirements of said General Order are complied with.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
