O R D E R

City of Coalinga, Fresno County, is authorized to construct a public road at grade across a branch line track of Southern Pacific Company in that city, at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. ED-267.7. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than 24 feet and grades of approach not greater than 3 per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs. (G.O. No. 75-B).

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

Said crossing is required for access to recently acquired property of the Coalinga Union High School District and is urgently

needed for development of the property. For this reason the effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
