O R D E R

The Sacramento Northern Railway, applicant, is authorized to construct a track at grade across 19th Street and along and across "C" Street and abandon trackage in said "C" Street in the City of Sacramento at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. 8H-0.12. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense also maintenance cost between lines two feet outside of rails. The City of Sacramento shall bear maintenance cost outside of such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than 24 feet and grades of approach not greater than four percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.O. No. 72. Protection shall be by one Standard No. 1 crossing sign. (G.O. No. 75-B).

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
