FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

By Decision No. 45899, dated June 29, 1951, the Commission authorized Louis M. Goodman and Goodman Delivery Service, Inc. to sell and transfer their operative rights to 20th Century Delivery Service, Inc. The order of the Commission authorized such sale and transfer to be made on or before September 30, 1951.

Applicants now have informed the Commission that they have been unable to complete the arrangements to carry out the transfer and will be unable to do so prior to the expiration of the time limit set in the Commission's order. Accordingly, they have asked that the order be modified so as to grant to them an extension of time to and including November 30, 1951.

The Commission has considered this matter and is of the opinion that the request of applicants should be granted; therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the order in Decision No. 45899, dated June 29, 1951, be, and it hereby is, amended so as

to permit Louis M. Goodman and Goodman Delivery Service, Inc. to transfer their operative rights to 20th Century Delivery Service, Inc. on or before November 30, 1951.

This first supplemental order is effective upon the date hereof.
