O P I N I O N

Walter J. Johnson and Rose A. Johnson herein request authority to serve Marysville Cantonment, Camp Beale, California, as an extension of their existing highway common carrier service.

The application is supported by the affidavit of the adjutant of the Air Base Squadron at Camp Beale, which states that the service of applicants is necessary in the reactivation and maintenance of Camp Beale.

Valley Motor Lines, Inc. and Pacific Motor Trucking Company, the only highway common carriers serving Camp Beale, have signified in writing that they have no objection to the granting of the application. Under the circumstances, a public hearing does not appear to be necessary.

Upon the facts appearing in the application and affidavit filed herein, we find that public convenience and necessity require that Walter J. Johnson and Rose A. Johnson be authorized to establish and operate the proposed highway common carrier service.

O R D E R

Application as above entitled having been filed and the Commission having found that public convenience and necessity so require,

IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That a certificate of public convenience and necessity be and it is hereby granted to Walter J. Johnson and Rose A. Johnson authorizing the establishment and operation of a service as a highway common carrier (as defined in Section 2-3/4 of the Public Utilities Act) for the transportation of general commodities except uncrated household goods and personal effects, uncrated livestock, liquid petroleum in bulk, and articles of unusual value, between all points and places authorized to be served by their present certificates, on the one hand, and Marysville Cantonment, Camp Beale, California, on the other hand.

(2) That, in providing service pursuant to the certificate herein granted, applicants shall comply with and observe the following service regulations:

- (a) Within thirty (30) days after the effective date hereof, applicants shall file a written acceptance of the certificate herein granted.
- (b) Within sixty (60) days after the effective date hereof, and upon not less than five (5) days' notice to the Commission and the public, applicants shall establish the service herein authorized, and comply with the provisions of General Order No. 80 and Part IV of General Order No. 93-A by filing, in triplicate, and concurrently making effective, tariffs and time schedules satisfactory to the Commission.
- (c) Subject to the authority of this Commission to change or modify them by further order, applicants shall conduct operations pursuant to the certificate herein granted

over and along the following routes: between Marysville
and Camp Beale: unnumbered road.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty (20) days
after the date hereof.
