O R D E R

The Department of Public Works of the State of California is authorized to relocate the crossing of Temperance Avenue at grade with a track of Southern Pacific Company, (Crossing No. B-216.3) near Fowler, Fresno County, as described in the application and in accordance with the plan attached thereto. Width of crossing shall be not less than 24 feet and grades of approach substantially as shown on Exhibit "A" attached to the application. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs. (G. O. No. 75-B).

Construction expense shall be apportioned by agreement between the parties or, if they fail to agree, by further order of the Commission. Maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails shall be borne by applicant. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines.

Upon completion, the existing crossing of Temperance Avenue, about 300 feet northwesterly, and a private crossing about 670 feet southeasterly shall be abandoned and closed.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be

extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authoriza-  
tion may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity,  
or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be  
twenty days after the date hereof.
