O R D E R

Sacramento Northern Railway is authorized to construct a side track at grade across portions of Alhambra Boulevard and across the intersections at "Q" Street and two alleys with said Alhambra Boulevard in Sacramento, Sacramento County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as portions of Crossings No. 8H-2.11, No. 8H-2.07-D and No. 8H-2.12-D. Construction of said crossings shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding two percent. Protection shall be by existing Standard No. 1 crossing signs (G.O. No. 75-B). Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days  
after the date hereof.
