FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

In Decision No. 45941 San Joaquin County was authorized to reconstruct an existing crossing and said order provided that the reconstructed crossing be protected by two Standard No. 3 crossing signals. Applicant now desires to use Standard No. 8 flashing light signals in lieu of the Standard No. 3 wigwags, and has requested modification of the order.

Good Cause Appearing, IT IS ORDERED that Decision No. 45941 is hereby modified to provide that protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 crossing signals (G. O. No. 75-B) in lieu of the Standard No. 3 crossing signals therein required. In all other respects said Decision No. 45941 is in full force and effect.
