FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

In Decision 46281, dated October 8, 1951, the Southern Pacific Company was authorized to construct a spur track at grade across State Highway 41 near Crows Landing, Stanislaus County, to be identified as Crossing No. BA-110.1-C. The effective date of Decision No. 46281 was made 20 days after the date thereof.

It now appears that this spur is urgently needed to serve the United States Naval Auxilary Air Station and that the United States Navy desires to commence construction at once.

Good Cause Appearing, IT IS ORDERED that Decision No. 46281 is hereby modified to provide that the effective date shall be the date hereof. In all other respects said Decision No. 46281 is in full force and effect.
