FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Decision No. 43867, dated February 28, 1950, authorized Lillian A. Hotchkiss to purchase from Thomas J. Malatesta a passenger stage and express service between Almaden and San Jose.

Lillian A. Hotchkiss has petitioned for the revocation of the express rights, alleging that no express packages have ever been tendered to her and that the revocation of such rights would not adversely affect the public interest.

Now therefore, good cause appearing, IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity heretofore authorized to be transferred to Lillian A. Hotchkiss by Decision No. 43867, dated February 28, 1950, be and it is hereby amended to authorize the establishment and operation of a service as a passenger stage corporation, as defined in Section 2-1/4 of the Public Utilities Act, for the transportation of passengers only, between San Jose and Almaden and intermediate points.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty (20) days after the date hereof.
