ORDER AMENDING DECISION No. 45966

The ordering paragraph of Decision No. 45966, an order granting temporary interim relief in the above proceeding, reads as follows:

"IT IS ORDERED that The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company is hereby restrained and enjoined from discontinuing or disconnecting the telephone service now being furnished to petitioner at the above-referred to address pending a hearing before this Commission and further order thereon. The complaint, assigned to Commissioner Huls, is set for hearing before Commissioner Huls or such Examiner, and at such time and place, as may hereafter be designated."

In granting temporary relief, it was the Commission's intent that continued service pursuant to that order would be furnished in accordance with the defendant's applicable tariff provisions on file with the Commission. Therefore, IT IS ORDERED that the ordering paragraph of Decision No. 45966 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"IT IS ORDERED that The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company is hereby restrained and enjoined from discontinuing or disconnecting

the telephone service now being furnished to petitioner at the above-referred to address pending a hearing before this Commission and further order thereon. Service continued pursuant to this order may be discontinued for nonpayment of proper bills for such service, or for noncompliance with defendant's filed rules applicable to such service. The complaint, assigned to Commissioner Huls, is set for hearing before Commissioner Huls or such Examiner, and at such time and place, as may hereafter be designated."

This order shall become effective on the date hereof.
