ORIGINAL

O R D E R

The City of Willits is authorized to construct a public road at grade across the main line track of California Western Railroad in the City of Willits, Mendocino County, at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. 17-39.0. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. California Western Railroad shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than 24 feet and grades of approach not greater than 4 per cent on the south and 3 per cent on the north. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 Flashing Light Signals (G. O. No. 75-B).

The City requests authority to start immediate construction of a footpath at the same location to be protected by a Standard No. 1 Sign for the use of pedestrians until the road with No. 8 Flashing Light Signals is completed for vehicular traffic; therefore,

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that pending completion of the public road crossing a suitable footpath be constructed at said location. Protection shall be by one Standard No. 1 Crossing Sign.(G.O. No. 75-B)

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within two years unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or

safety so require.

Applicant desires to complete footpath prior to imminent rainy season and requests that this authority be made effective immediately. The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
