ORDER

The Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct one spur track at grade across Vineland Avenue at Bassett, Los Angeles County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. B-497.8. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a minimum width of twenty-four feet, with tops of rails flush with roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding two per cent. Protection shall be by existing protective devices. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public conventence, necessity, or safety so require.

As the industry to be served desires to utilize its track at as early a date as possible, applicant requests that the order be made effective on its date. For this reason the effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
