O R D E R

By this application Pacific Electric Railway Company, a corporation, seeks authority to single track its Monrovia-Glendora Line between Shamrock Avenue and its San Gabriel River Bridge in the County of Los Angeles.

Applicant proposes to remove the second track on those portions where double tracks are now provided, as described in Paragraph III of the application and as shown on the map (C.E.H. 19439-a) attached to the application.

It appearing that a public hearing is not necessary herein, that operation over the single track as proposed will not be adverse to public interest, and that the application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Pacific Electric Railway Company is hereby authorized to single track its Monrovia-Glendora Line between Shamrock Avenue and its San Gabriel River Bridge in accordance with the plan described in the application.

Applicant shall, within thirty (30) days thereafter, notify this Commission in writing of the abandonment of the

facilities authorized herein and of its compliance with the conditions hereof. The authorization herein granted shall become void if not exercised within one (1) year from the date hereof, unless further time is granted by subsequent order.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty (20) days after the date hereof.
