In the matter of the application of )  
 PACIFIC ELECTRIC RAILWAY COMPANY for )  
 approval of installation of "exempt ) Application No. 32687  
 signs" at crossing of Union Pacific )  
 spur track in City of Glendale at )  
 Glendale Avenue and California Street. )

O R D E R

The Union Pacific Railroad Company having waived protest,  
 IT IS ORDERED that approval is hereby granted for the  
 display of distinctive "exempt signs" (Vehicle Code Section 576 (d);  
 G. O. No. 98) at the spur track crossing California Street, City  
 of Glendale, Crossing No. 3C-8.21-C.

Such signs shall comply with G. O. No. 98 and shall be  
 erected and maintained by the proper authorities. If any sign is  
 removed, or the view thereof obstructed, vehicles carrying passengers  
 for hire must come to a full and complete stop before passing over  
 the crossing.

Within thirty (30) days after erection of such signs  
 applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This approval  
 does not exempt any vehicle operator from the observance of any  
 provision of the Vehicle Code, and shall become void if signs are  
 not displayed within one year, unless time be extended, or if  
 above conditions are not complied with. Approval may be revoked

or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty (20) days after the date hereof.
