O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct spur track at grade across Seventh Street in Berkeley, Alameda County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. A-8.28-C. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.O. No. 72, without super-elevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding two per cent. Protection shall be by existing Standard No. 1 crossing sign (G.O. No. 75-B). Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

Applicant states that the track is required to handle

canned goods and other food products for the military services and immediate construction is desirable. Therefore the effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
