O R D E R

The verified application of Tidewater Southern Railway Company discloses that no passenger or freight business has been transacted at applicant's stations of Sexton, San Joaquin County, Stewart and Shoemake, Stanislaus County, and Tegner, Merced County, during the past two years and that continued maintenance thereof is not necessary.

Good Cause Appearing, Tidewater Southern Railway Company is authorized to abandon its non-agency stations of Sexton, Stewart, Shoemake and Tegner; to remove a spur track at each of said stations; to eliminate said names from its station records; and to cancel all tariffs and time schedules applying at said stations on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and the public.

Within thirty days after abandonment and removal of the facilities as authorized herein, applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
