O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to temporarily relocate its main branch line track and a drill track at grade across 13th Street and Laurel Street in and in the vicinity of Lompoc, Santa Barbara County, at the locations described in the application, (Crossing No. EH-311-3). Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding two per cent. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (G.O. No. 75-B). Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Said relocation is required to facilitate construction of a flood control culvert and upon completion of such culvert applicant shall restore the tracks to the present locations.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The soil conservation service of the United States Department of Agriculture has orally requested that this order be made effective as of its date. Therefore the effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
