OPINION AND ORDER

Pacific Freight Lines, a corporation, has filed this application for authority to sell, for \$7,500, certain real property together with improvements, located in the City of Brawley and described as follows:

Lots 8, 9 and 10, in Block 81, of the Townsite of Brawley, City of Brawley, County of Imperial, State of California, as per map thereof No. 920, filed in the Office of the County Recorder of San Diego County.

Applicant reports that the premises formerly were used by it as a freight terminal in the City of Brawley, that on August 1, 1951, it closed its terminal and commenced handling all of its business in the Brawley territory through its El Centro office, and that the properties it now proposes to sell became nonoperating in character and no longer useful in its business. Applicant reports that its service was not affected by this change in operation.

The Commission has considered this matter and is of the opinion that it should enter an order as herein provided; therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:

1. Pacific Freight Lines, after the effective date hereof and on or before December 31, 1951, may sell the properties referred to in this application under the terms set forth therein.

2. The authority herein granted will become effective twenty (20) days after the date hereof.
