In the matter of the Application of the People of the State of California on relation of the Department of Public Works for an order authorizing abolition of crossing at grade of State Highway Route 171 and track of the Southern Pacific Company at Stanton Avenue in Orange County, State of California.

ORDER

In this application the Department of Public Works of the State of California requests authority to eliminate the existing crossing at grade of State Highway Route 171 with Southern Pacific Company's tracks in the town of Stanton, Orange County, Crossing No. BAA-513.9. Southern Pacific Company has formally notified the Commission that it has no objection to the elimination of this crossing.

Good Cause Appearing, IT IS ORDERED that the Department of Public Works of the State of California is authorized to abolish the crossing by physical removal of the track of Southern Pacific Company at grade over State Highway Route 171, in the town of Stanton, Orange County, identified as Crossing No. BAA-513.9, as more particularly shown on map attached to the application. In abolishing said crossing, applicant shall cause to have the track removed within the limits of its right of way and a suitable bumper erected on the end of the remaining portion of track at the easterly limits of the right of way.

Expense of the removal of track, removal of two Standard No. 1 signs, and installation of suitable bumper as hereinabove provided shall be apportioned by agreement between the parties or, if they fail to agree, by further order of the Commission.

Authorization shall become void if not exercised within one (1) year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty (20) days after the date hereof.
