FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

In Decision No. 46356, in the above entitled application, the Commission authorized the construction of certain grade separations, among them being a crossing at separated grades of Almanson Avenue, and the closing of several grade crossings in the City of Alhambra. Inadvertently provision for the closing of the existing grade crossing at Almanson Avenue upon completion of grade separation was omitted, therefore, Good Cause Appearing

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Decision No. 46356 is amended to provide that, upon the completion of the grade separation of Almanson Avenue with the Covina line of Pacific Electric Railway Company, the existing grade crossing of said Almanson Avenue, Crossing No. 6T-8.48, shall be immediately closed and abandoned.

In all other respects said Decision No. 46356 is in full force and effect.
