FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

By Decision No. 46405, dated November 13, 1951, the Commission authorized Coast Counties Gas and Electric Company to issue and sell \$3,000,000 principal amount of its First Mortgage Bonds, 3-1/2% Series, due 1981. The order of the Commission provided that the authority to issue and sell bonds will become effective when Coast Counties Gas and Electric Company paid the fee prescribed by Section 1904 of the Public Utilities Code and when the Commission, by supplemental order, authorized applicant to execute a Fourth Supplemental Indenture.

On November 13 applicant paid the required fee. On November 23 it filed a copy, in final form, of its proposed Fourth Supplemental Indenture and requested the Commission to make an order authorizing it to execute the same.

The Commission has considered this request and is of the opinion that it should be granted; therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Coast Counties Gas and Electric Company be, and it hereby is, authorized to execute a Fourth Supplemental Indenture dated as of November 1, 1951, in the same form as that filed in this proceeding on November 23, 1951.

This first supplemental order is effective upon the date hereof.
