ORDER GRANTING TEMPORARY INTERIM RELIEF

Clark has filed a verified complaint alleging in substance that complainant's telephone service at 13500 East Los Angeles Street, Baldwin Park, California, under telephone number Fleetwood 75583, has been disconnected by defendant; that said communication facilities were not used as an instrumentality to violate the law, nor in aiding or abetting such violation, but were in fact used for personal and social calls; and that complainant will suffer irreparable injury, hardship, and financial loss unless we said communication facilities are immediately restored; therefore,

Associated Telephone Company, 140, referred to in the compaint a IT IS ORDERED that The Associated Telephone and Telegraph Company is hereby directed to restore telephone service to complainant pending hearing on said complaint and further Commission order thereon, such service to be furnished pursuant to defendant's filed tariff rates and rules applicable thereto. The complaint will be set for hearing before such Commissioner or Examiner, and at such time and place, as may hereafter be designated.
