The State Park Commission of the State of California is authorized to construct a public trail, known as the State Master Loop Riding and Miking trail, at grade across the main line tracks of Southern Pacific Company near Tehachapi, Kern County, at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. B-368.1-D. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not greater than ten feet and grades of approach not greater than six per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 1 of G.O. No. 72. Protection shall be by Standard No. 1 crossing signs. (G.O. No. 75-B), and by self-closing gates at the railroad right of way lines.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with.

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Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
