O R D E R

In this application Contra Costa County requests approval of the installation of stop signs at crossing of County Road No. 7941 with a main line track of Southern Pacific Company in the vicinity of Byron, Crossing No. B-67.1. Ordinance No. 650 has been passed by the Board of Supervisors of Contra Costa County, and a copy thereof is attached to the application.

It appearing that the installation of such signs is in the interest of public safety and that approval should be granted,

IT IS ORDERED that the installation and maintenance of stop signs at Crossing No. B-67.1 of County Road No. 7941 with a main line track of Southern Pacific Company in Byron, Contra Costa County, is hereby approved.

The cost of erection and maintenance of such stop signs shall be in accordance with an agreement between the County of Contra Costa and Southern Pacific Company.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year

unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
