ORDER OF REVOCATION

By Decision No. 39620 dated November 15, 1946, H. F. Adams, A. C. Hamlin and E. J. Pann doing business as ABH Lines were granted a certificate authorizing a passenger stage service between U. S. Navy Hospital at Norco, on the one hand, and, on the other hand, Ontario, Pomona and Los Angeles. Their first supplemental application states that they are no longer providing service between those points and requests revocation of the certificate granted by said Decision No. 39620. Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the operative rights granted by Decision No. 39620 in Application No. 27391 are hereby revoked and annulled and all effective tariffs and timetables on file in applicants' names are hereby cancelled.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty (20) days after the date hereof.
