## SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Decision No. 46523 of December 11, 1951, in this proceeding, authorized the rail lines and Pacific Motor Trucking Company to defer, until a date not later than June 30, 1952, the filing of revisions to certain tariffs pursuant to Decisions Nos. 46022 and 46028 of July 31, 1951, and Decisions Nos. 46434, 46435 and 46436 of November 20, 1951. By petition filed December 13, 1951, Santa Fe Transportation Company, a highway common carrier affiliate of The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway, asks for the same authority with respect to its Rex Division Tariff 7-A, Cal.P.U.C. No. 11.

Petitioner represents that through inadvertence the tariff in question was not included in the general rail line, petition; that certain of the rates in that tariff are maintained on the same basis as rail rates; and that the sought extension is necessary for the same reasons as those set forth in the petition disposed of by Decision No. 46523.

It appears that petitioner's sought extension of time in which to file amendments to its Rex Division tariff should be granted. Decision No. 46523 will be amended accordingly.

A public hearing is not necessary.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Decision No. 46523 of December 11, 1951, in this proceeding, be and it is hereby amended so that the authority therein granted will include Santa Fe Transportation Company's Rex Division Tariff No. 7-A, Cal.P.U.C. No. 11.

In all other respects the aforesaid Decision No. 46523 shall remain in full force and effect.
