## FIRST STPPLEMETIAL ORDER

By Decision No. 46124, dated August 28, 1951, the Comsission authorized Philip R. Colrins and George T. Story to execute a deed of trust and a mortgagc of chattels and to issue a pronissory note in the princtpai amount of not exceeding $\$ 182,000$ for the purpose of financing the cost of buik storage facilities for their warcinouse business in Sutter County. The time witinin which applicants may excoute the indentures and issue the note will teminate on Decomber 32, 1952.

Appiscants now report that they have encountered delays in obtaining materials required for the constraction of the proposed facilities and that tiery will not be in a position to consuramate the transaction beforc December 31, 1951. Accordingly, tincy have requested an extension of time to Ap=il 30, 2952.

The Compission has considered applicants' request andis of the opinion thet it should be granted; therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:

1. The order in Decision No. 46124, dated August 28, 2951, is amended so as to permit Philip R. Collins and George T. Story to execute the deed of trust and mortgage of chattels and to issue the note authorized therein on or before april 30,' 1952.
2. This order will become effective upon the date hereof.
