O R D E R

The City of Burbank is authorized to construct Keystone Street at grade across Burbank Branch of Southern Pacific Company in the City of Burbank, Los Angeles County, at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. BY-465.6. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than 48 feet and grades of approach not greater than four percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B).

Within thirty (30) days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one (1) year, unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied.

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with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty (20) days after the date hereof.
