BEFORE THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the Matter of the Application of City of Long Beach, a municipal corporation, for the establishment at grade of a crossing on a street to be constructed and known as 12th Street over a teamster spur track of the Pacific Electric Railway Company, by a public street, in the City of Long Beach, County of Los Angeles, State of California.

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The City of Long Beach is authorized to construct 12th Street at grade across a spur track of Pacific Electric Railway Company in the City of Long Beach, Los Angeles County, at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. 6LA-19.42-C. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Pacific Electric Railway Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than 40 feet and grades of approach not greater than two percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1-A crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B).

Within thirty (30) days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one (1) year, unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied

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with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty (20) days after the date hereof.
