O R D E R

The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company is authorized to construct a spur track at grade across 28th Street in the City of San Diego, San Diego County, at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. 2-271.03-C. Applicant shall bear the entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72 without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding one percent. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B).

Within thirty (30) days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one (1) year, unless time be extended or if above conditions are not

complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty (20) days after the date hereof.
