## ORDER

The State of California, Department of Public Works, is authorized to widen, reconstruct and rearrange the crossing of a portion of the Redwood Highway at grade with a track of Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company, (Crossing No. 5-16.65-C) in San Rafael, Harin County, as described in the application and in accordance with the plan attached thereto. Width of crossing shall be not less than the paved area of the highway and grades of approach not greater than three per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard Mo. 2 of G.O. No. 72. Protection shall be by four Standard No. 8 flashing light signals. (C.O. No. 75-B).

Construction expense shall be apportioned by agreement between the parties or, if they fail to agree, by further order of the Commission. Maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails shall be borne by applicant. Northwestern Pacific Railroad. Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines.

Upon completion, the trackage shall be removed from Crossing No. 5-16.6-C located about two hundred feet southeasterly from the crossing to be improved and said Crossing No. 5-16.6-C shall be eliminated.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
