FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Santa Paula Water Works, Ltd., a corporation, by its first supplemental application filed December 20, 1951, seeks authority to renew its agreement with F. E. Fairfield, oil property operator, to lease for a period of one year certain limited priorities under water rights owned by applicant. Copy of the agreement between F. E. Fairfield, an individual, and applicant, dated December 14, 1951, is attached to the first supplemental application as Exhibit "A" thereof. It sets forth certain limited priorities for water rights owned by applicant for a one-year period.

Since no change in the amount of water allowed by applicant to be taken by Fairfield from Santa Paula Creek is indicated, such amount being not in excess of 850 cubic feet of water per 24-hour day, and not in excess of 300,000 cubic feet of water per year, it is evident that the total water supply available to applicant's regular customers in and about the City of Santa Paula, as set out in the opinion and order in Decision No. 45308, will in no way be jeopardized.

It appearing that a public hearing is not necessary herein and that the permissive use of said priorities under certain of applicant's water rights by F. E. Fairfield, in accordance with the above-referred to agreement, is not adverse to the public interest, and that the application should be granted subject to certain conditions, *as set out in the ~~agreement~~ ^{agreement}*

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Santa Paula Water Works, Ltd. is authorized to carry out the terms and provisions of its renewed agreement with F. E. Fairfield, dated December 14, 1951, as set forth in Exhibit "A" attached to the first supplemental application herein, which exhibit is hereby made a part of this order by reference.

Applicant shall notify this Commission of the termination of this agreement within thirty (30) days after the date of said termination.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty (20) days from the date hereof.
