SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By petition filed January 31, 1952, Fortier Transportation Company asks for authority to defer, until a date not later than June 30, 1952, the filing of changes in tariff provisions pursuant to Decisions Nos. 46022, 46026 and 46028 of July 31, 1951, as amended. These decisions established revised constructive highway mileages, effective January 1, 1952.

Petitioner alleges that its tariff publishing agent was not able to compile the necessary tariff revisions within the prescribed time and that on like representations rail lines and other common carriers were granted relief similar to that here sought.

Decision No. 46026, involved in petitioner's request, covers bulk petroleum and petroleum products rates. Decision No. 46486 of December 4, 1951, has postponed the application of the revised mileages until further order of the Commission insofar as these rates are concerned. In other respects, it appears that petitioner should be granted authority similar to that previously granted other carriers under like circumstances. A public hearing is not necessary.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that petitioner be and it is hereby authorized to defer, until a date not later than June 30, 1952, the filing of revisions of its tariffs pursuant to Decisions Nos. 46022, and 46028 of July 31, 1951, and Decisions Nos. 46434, 46435 and 46436 of November 20, 1951.

This order shall become effective on the date hereof.
