BEFORE THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the Matter of the Application of Pacific Electric Railway Company, a corporation, for a preliminary order to construct, operate and maintain a drill and spur track across Chadron and Simms Avenues, located west of Crenshaw Blvd. and south of El Segundo Blvd. on Applicant's El Segundo Line.

O R D E R

Pacific Electric Railway Company is authorized to construct two spur tracks at grade across Chadron Avenue, also Simms Avenue, near the City of Hawthorne, Los Angeles County, at the locations described in the application to be identified as Crossings Nos. 6RA-13.60-C and 6RA-13.69-C respectively. Applicant shall bear the entire construction and maintenance expense.

Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, without superelevation and of widths to conform to the portions of the streets now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding two per cent. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs at each location (G. O. No. 75-B).

Within thirty (30) days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one (1) year, unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public

convenience, necessity or safety so require.

As the industries to be served desire to utilize these tracks at as early a date as possible, applicant requests that the order be made effective on its date. For this reason the effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
