FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 46733, dated February 5, 1952, in Application No. 33062, the Commission authorized Eureka-Redding Stages, Inc. to purchase and Thomas B. Riley and Ethelyn M. Riley doing business as Trinity Bus Line to sell the operative rights granted in Decision No. 39326, dated August 13, 1946, in Application No. 27655 and in Decision No. 41137, dated January 19, 1948, in Application No. 28870.

Decision No. 39326 authorized the transportation of passengers and hand baggage between Redding and Shasta on sight-seeing trips. Decision No. 41137 authorized the transportation of passengers, baggage and express weighing 100 pounds or less on passenger carrying vehicles only, between Eureka and Redding and intermediate points via Arcata, Blue Lake, Willow Creek, Weaverville, Douglas City, Tower House, French Gulch and Shasta with divergence at Tower House to French Gulch subject to the restriction that no passengers, baggage or express may be transported having both point of origin and point of destination on U. S. Highway 101 between Eureka and the junction of said highway with U. S. Highway 299.

Although the joint application alleged the intention to

transfer the "entire operative rights" of Thomas B. Riley and Ethelyn M. Riley, the Commission has been informed by the attorney for applicants that it was not intended to transfer the sight-seeing rights, but only those operative rights between Eureka and Redding and intermediate points.

Therefore good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That paragraph (1) of Decision No. 46733, dated February 5, 1952, in Application No. 33062, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"(1) That after the effective date hereof and on or before May 15, 1952, Thomas B. Riley and Ethelyn M. Riley may sell and transfer to Eureka-Redding Stages, Inc. the operative rights authorized in Decision No. 41137, dated January 19, 1948, in Application No. 28870."

(2) That in all other respects Decision No. 46733 shall remain in full force and effect.
