## SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

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City Carriers' Tariff No. 6 - Highway Carriers' Tariff No. 7 provides minimum rates for the transportation of specified materials, including sand and gravel, within Ventura County. Zone rates are provided for movements from defined production areas to designated delivery zones. Special point-to-point rates are provided for volume movements between production areas and commercial processing plants. Mileage rates and hourly rates apply between points not covered by the zone and point-to-point rates. The mileage rates are generally higher than the other rates. By petition filed February 26, 1952, Santa Paula Rock Company seeks the establishment of a point-to-point rate of 54 cents per ton for the movement of sand and gravel from a pit located in Grimes Canyon to a commercial processing plant located in Santa Paula.

Petitioner represents that a minimum of 15,000 tons of sand and gravel is expected to be produced at the Grimes Canyon pit each year and that these materials will be transported entirely by forhire trucks. It claims that point-to-point rates are provided for like transportation under similar conditions and that establishment of the proposed rate is necessary to provide reasonable and equitable charges. With respect to the level of the proposed 64-cent rate, petitioner compares it with a 60-cent zone rate applicable in the

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same general vicinity and based upon an average distance slightly less than that involved in the petition here being considered.

Interested parties have been notified of the filing of the petition. California Dump Truck Owners Association has supported and no one has opposed its being granted.

It appears that establishment of the proposed rate is justified for the reasons advanced. A public hearing is not necessary.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that City Carriers' Tariff No. 6 -Highway Carriers' Tariff No. 7 (Appendix "A" of Decision No. 32566, as amended) be and it is hereby further amended by incorporating therein the revised pages attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof, numbered as follows:
