ORDER OF DISMISSAL

American Stevedore Company, a corporation, having filed Application No. 32162 on February 27, 1951, requesting a certificate of public convenience and necessity authorizing the establishment of operations as a highway common carrier between points within the State from Kingsburg and Monterey on the south to Eureka on the north; and it appearing that the matter originally was set for hearing on August 9, 1951, was temporarily removed from the calendar on July 24, 1951, at applicant's request; that applicant's attorney was notified in writing on January 29, 1952, that no affirmative action had been taken for almost a year and failure to promptly inform the Commission of an intention to proceed with the matter would result in the entry of an order of dismissal; that no reply thereto has been received, now therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that Application No. 32162 is hereby dismissed for want of prosecution.
