## FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

By Decision No. 45853, dated June 26, 1951, the Commission authorized Margaret R. Utt, the owner and operator of the Tustin Water Works, to issue promissory notes in the aggregate principal amount of \$80,000, payable on or before June 1, 1966, with interest at the rate of 1% per annum for the purpose of paying indebtedness and of financing the cost of additions to the water works properties.

In a first supplemental application filed on March 7, 1952, applicant reports that it was impossible to obtain all the required materials during 1951 and that consequently not all the notes authorized by the Commission were issued. She requests an extension of time of one year within which to issue said notes.

The Commission has considered this matter and is of the opinion that applicant's request should be granted; therefore,

## IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:

1. The order in Decision No. 45853, dated June 26, 1951, hereby is amended so as to permit Margaret R. Utt to issue

the notes authorized therein on or before December 31, 1952.

2. This first supplemental order is effective upon the date hereof.
